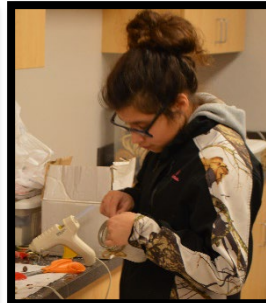


Financial Fitness
